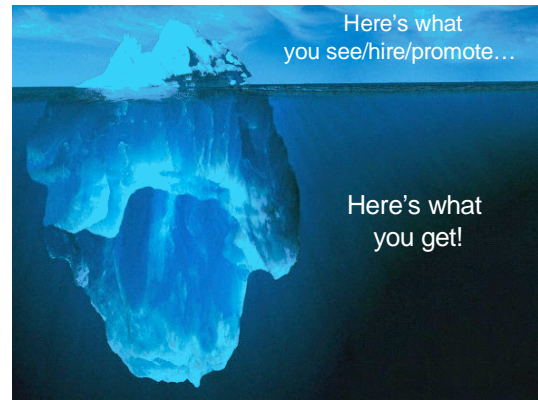


The Workforce Crisis
